* Registration Refund: Full refund first three weeks of rehearsal, 1/2 registration refund 4th and 5th weeks, no registration refund after 6th week.

*Rental Refund: Full rent amount of unused months returned, no rent returned for any portion of the calendar month an instrument is turned in.

*Book Refund: No refund given if book is not in perfect condition or after 6th week of rehearsals.
